MORNINGS



- Line up at 8.40

CURRICULUM CONTENT



- We will be teaching the full Year 1 National Curriculum.
- Work is varied to cater for the different abilities of the children and the children's interests.
- Children are ability grouped for maths and English, but they will not necessarily always sit in these groups.
- We have three teaching assistants working in the class - Mrs Darley, Mrs Murfitt and Mr Savage.

PHONICS AND HIGH FREQUENCY TO THE WORDS

- In Year 1 pupils will take part in a phonics screening check during the summer term.
- The screening check assesses their ability to segment and blend phonemes.
- Pupils should also be able to read and spell high frequency words that are found frequently in texts.
- Phonics lessons are carried out twice daily.

HOMEWORK



• Reading:

- The children will change their book weekly on allocated days.
- Expected to read at home a minimum of five times a week.
- Home reading record to detail what has been read.
- RIBIT (Read In Bed It's Terrific) certificates for signed reads on 5 different nights in a week.
- 10 certificates = a free book.

PE



- The children will have P.E. twice a week, Thursdays and Fridays.
- Comprising:
- Plimsolls or trainers, (children will need to run in these).
- Ditton Lodge purple T-shirt.
- Plain dark shorts.
- Outdoor Kit: jogging bottoms or leggings (dark coloured).
- A sweatshirt or Ditton Lodge hoodie (not their uniform jumper).
- forings should not be worn on P.E. days for ty reasons.

SCHOOL UNIFORM



- Please ensure that your child comes to school every day in the correct school uniform and that school shoes, not trainers, are worn unless it is a P.E. day.
- All school uniform should be named.
- Particularly sweat-shirts/fleeces are named.



OING HOME



- If your child is going home with another adult, please speak to the class teacher in the morning.
- If you have to make alternative arrangements at the end of the school day due to unforeseen circumstances, please inform the school office.



GENERAL

- Early Work is an important start to the day so please make sure your child arrives promptly in school each morning.
- It is really helpful if your child can bring a water bottle to school every day (in addition to a packed-lunch drink as children are not allowed back into the classrooms).
- P.E. lessons take place on Thursday and Friday. Please ensure that your child comes to school appropriately dressed for the weather as we will try to go outside.
- Please no jewellery, sweatbands or charity bands.
- Children with long hair need to have it tied back please.



PACKED LUNCHES

- Ditton Lodge have a healthy eating policy so we ask that children's packed lunches are balanced and nutritious.
- Please only pack the amount you expect your child to eat.
- No sweets or chocolate bars (chocolate covered biscuits as an occasional treat are acceptable).
- We are a NUT FREE school so please ensure that nut products are not included in packed lunches.
- Items that state 'may contain nuts' on packaging are fine.
