This week our class spotlight is on Year Five

In Maths this week, our focus has been solving multi-step problems using addition and subtraction. Our writing topic is formal letters of application, we are going to be applying to Mrs Tweed for a position of office assistant using persuasive devices and formal tone. We are coming to the end our first reading block and finishing the book 'Shackleton's Journey'. We have discovered how Shackleton lead his crew on a perilous expedition to Antarctica. In Science we have been learning about properties and changes of materials, including investigating which changes are reversible and which are irreversible. Harvest Festival has been our learning focus in RE and Hockey skills are what we practising with Mrs Paskell in PE.

This week our subject spotlight is PSHE

The children have shown great enthusiasm in their weekly PSHE lessons. EYFS have been thinking about kindness linked to the text 'The Squirrels that squabbled'. In Year 1 the children have been learning how different feelings make us behave and learning some strategies to help us manage 'not so good feelings. Year 4 have been exploring feelings and emotions and how this links to the physical state and British values. Year 5 have been learning about conflict resolutions, using drama to act out different scenarios and use negotiation and compromise to resolve a dispute. Year 6 have continued their learning of positive relationships and used a play script to explore different behaviours in peer groups and strategies to deal assertively in different situations.
