## This week our class spotlight is Year Three

Year 3 have had a fantastic term learning about lots of different, exciting topics. We have been focusing on measuring the perimeter of shapes and converting mm to cm. In reading, we have finished our exciting adventure book, Sam Wu is Not Afraid of the Dark. We have practiced our retrieval and inference skills, thinking deeply about the text and understanding the characters. This term, we have continued to compare the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age in History. We have learnt about the roundhouses they lived in and about the different rituals they followed. In Science, we have started a new topic about forces. We have carried out some interesting experiments to understand how to measure in newtons and to see how different materials create more friction. Year 3 are really enjoying tennis and cricket in PE, focusing on throwing, catching and hand eye coordination skills. In Art, we have been practicing print making using tie-dye and water colours, we especially enjoyed the art festival! We are looking forward to another great term!

## This week our subject spotlight is PE

Early years have been learning how to move safely around the hall. They have practised finding their own spaces and freezing in different positions. They have also been playing team games to encourage good listening skills and how to respond appropriately to their partners actions. In Year 1, the children have been learning skills to play invasion games. They have learnt about attackers and defenders and the purpose of each of these roles in invasion games such as football and basketball. Pupils in Year 3 have been learning tennis skills. They have learnt how to hold a racket correctly and use their forehand to hit a ball back over a tennis net. In Year 4, children have been learning ball skills in tennis to prepare them for hitting ground strokes. Children have been perfecting their forehand technique and improving their consistency by rallying. Year 5 have been working on their netball skills, practising chest, bounce, and shoulder passes. Also making sure that their feet are 'glued to the floor' when they have possession of the ball. In Year 6, the class have been working on improving their fitness, focusing on balance, coordination, agility, strength, stamina and speed. It has been great to see their fitness improving and pupils' beating their personal best on the fitness activities.
