


This week our class spotlight is on Year Two

This week has been another fantastic week of learning in Year 2. In Maths, we have been looking at place value and comparing numbers between 0-100, using manipulatives such as Base 10. We have been constructing expanded noun phrases to describe a chosen character from 'Grandad's Island'. The children have selected some powerful adjectives. In art, we have torn and glued different types of paper into our sketch books to create a textured background on which we made marks in contrasting colours. In science we have revisited the features of living things and used them to discuss the features that plants and animals have in common. Mrs Murfet and I are so impressed with your behaviour for learning. Keep it up Year 2 and aim for the stars!

This week our subject spotlight is Geography

The children have started their geography for this term with lots of interesting topics ahead. Reception have been settling in to life at school and learning where everything is. Year 1 will be looking at maps and symbols to locate different continents and oceans. The children in Year 2 have been looking at the features they would expect to find in different locations. This looks at human and physical geography. Year 3 are working on map and fieldwork skills, they have started this unit of work looking at the 8 points on a compass. Pupils in Year 4 are looking at rivers. They have started by looking at the features of a river. Year 5 are studying the location of countries of the world, including biomes and environmental regions. They have looked at where some of the major countries of the world are located. Children in Year 6 have been looking at physical processes: earthquakes, mountains and volcanoes. Their first focus has been discovering what makes up the layers of planet Earth.
