#### This week our subject spotlight is on History

What an exciting start to our History this year! In Reception, the children have been comparing their lives as babies to now. Year 1 have been looking at important places in our community, such as shops, schools and parks. The children in Year 2 have been finding out about The Great Fire of London and how it started. In Year 3, the children are becoming more expert on the periods of the Stone Age; the Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic periods. Year 4 have been learning about the Ancient Egyptians and looking at the Old Kingdom. Meanwhile in Year 5, the children have been exploring the Ancient Greeks and the city states of Athens and Sparta. Year 6 have been studying modern history and the causes of WW2.
