This week our class spotlight is on Year Four

This week in Year 4, we have completed our extended writing piece in English by penning persuasive adverts about password security. Children have employed technical vocabulary, rhetorical questions and bullet points as a means to engage the reader and organise information effectively. Having completed The Queen's Nose in Reading, we are now studying the dark and mysterious poem, The Raven, by Edgar Allan Poe, which contains high volumes of archaic language. Children have been honing their summarising, retrieval and comparative skills in conjunction with the text. In Maths, we have completed our lengthy unit of learning on Place Value and are now moving onto Subtraction and Addition. I have been very impressed with the children's understanding and application of Roman numerals. This week, the school enjoyed a visit by one of the world's top ten Freestyle Footballers, which complemented our ball skills in PE lessons. In DT, the children are learning about Food and Nutrition and have made homemade pizzas, bread rolls and tomato soup to complement the theory side of the lessons. This week our subject spotlight is Art

The children have been enjoying their weekly Art lessons over the last month and have been very busy! This half term's focus for all pupils is drawing and/or painting. EYFS have been exploring their creative area in the continuous provision and have been painting vehicles and self-portraits linked to their structured stories. Year One have been completing their unit on drawing and have been using a range of drawing tools such as: charcoal, chalk and pastel. Year Two have been exploring shape and texture through expressive mark making in response to Vivaldi's 'The Four Seasons' music. Year Three have been completing a unit on painting techniques, including tonking and sgraffito. Year Four have been refining their drawing skills, focusing on lines and detail. Year Five have learnt a new technique called subtractive drawing. They are studying the work of Hundertwasser and are using organic lines and spirals, along with bright colours and overlaying, to create abstract landscapes. Year Six have been learning techniques to draw in detail, using scale and proportion to modify their artwork.
