## **CURRICULUM CONTENT**



- We will be teaching the full Year 4 National Curriculum.
- Work is varied to cater for the different abilities of the children and the children's interests.
- Reading is taught for 30 minutes, followed by a Writing lesson each day. Spelling, Grammar and Handwriting are taught in separate lessons.
- We have **Mrs Nicholson** working with us during English and Maths lessons to support the children's learning.
- PE is taught on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons by Mr Smith
- Madam Marsh teaches French on Friday afternoons.
- Geography, History and PSHE are taught on a three weekly cycle.
- Science is taught for 2 weeks followed by Computing on a three weekly cycle.

# HOMEWORK

Reading:



- Please encourage your child to bring their reading book and record to school every day.
- The children will change their book weekly on allocated days.
- Expected to read at home a minimum of five times a week.
- Home reading record to detail what has been read.
- RIBIT (Read In Bed It's Terrific) stamps for signed reads on 5 different nights in a week. Certificates are only given out for multiples of ten. Weekly RIBITs are stamped in reading records with a frog.
- 10 certificates = a free book.
- As well as your child reading to you, it is also important to read to your children. Make reading aloud feel like a treat. Make it a special quiet time and cuddle up so that you can both see the book.
- Read through the whole story the first time without stopping too much. Let the story weave its own magic.
- Read with enjoyment. If you're not enjoying it, your child won't.
- Read favourite stories over and over again.

- Super Six will be set each Friday through Google Classroom and is due to be handed in by the following Thursday. There is no expectation to print it out at home. The children can see the questions on the screen and either type in their answers or write them in a note book. Please take a photo of their work and upload it to the classroom. # SCHOOL UNIFORM

- All school uniform should be <u>named.</u>
- Particularly sweat-shirts/fleeces are named.
